

Singer songwriter Ron Daniel is a son of Athens, Georgia. Always a lover of music, he was especially drawn to the guitar playing storytellers like James Taylor, Bob Dylan, and Jim Croce. After picking up the acoustic guitar at the age of eighteen he began what would be a twenty year run of playing covers. A late night barroom conversation with a fellow player in 2016 was the spark he needed to start writing originals. Within a year Ron was in the studio recording his first album, "In The Live Room", a humble but earnest capture of some of his first songs. Two more albums would follow. After completing the second album, "The Cottonwood Sessions" at Fairweather Studio in Charleston, SC, Ron had found his "voice" as an artist. The third and most recent album was another step up. Ron partnered with producer Doug Williams. Doug was the producer for the first two Avett Brothers albums. Traveling to Winston Salem, NC, Ron recorded at EMR Recorders with Doug Williams bringing out Ron's very best. The Album "Country Made For Kings" features incredible accompaniment players, most notably DaShawn Hickman on pedal steel. After the dust had settled on this third release Ron realized that none of his recordings were suitable for commercial radio play. Wanting to throw his hat in the ring of today's country artists he set out to make a modern country, commercial FM radio ready single. The process began in 2023 by enlisting the talents of producer Eric Barnett. Accompaniment players were hired and the hard work began. The song itself, the arrangement, the recording techniques, and most importantly, the mixing and mastering were all done to give the single "Boxcar" the best chance at a broad audience and radio play. "Boxcar" release date is August 9th, 2025 and will be available on Spotify, iTunes, Amazon Music, and YouTube.
